

Vote By Mail - General Information regarding delivery/return of Voter Kits

The voting kits for the 2010 Municipal Election will be mailed to eligible electors on October 1, 2010, and will include instructions for the completion of the documentation. The process requires each voter to complete his/her ballot and enclose it in the secrecy envelope, then sign the statutory declaration, and enclose the declaration and secrecy envelope in the return postage paid envelope.

Electors are asked to mail the return envelope as soon as it is completed, and it is recommended that it be mailed no later than October 16, 2010. After this date, it cannot be guaranteed by Canada Post that the envelope is received in time.

If you miss the suggested deadline, you have the option of delivering the ballot directly to the Lambton Shores - Forest Office, where there will be a polling station available from Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., from October 4, 2010 to October 25, 2010, and on Election Day, (October 25, 2010) from 8:30 a.m. until the close of polls at 8:00 p.m.

Not on the List?

The form to add or correct information on the preliminary list of electors is available on line at www.lambtonshores.ca under the Election 2010 section, or from any of the 3 municipal offices, and is to be returned to any office, or mailed to the Forest Office. (Please note: email or faxed forms are not acceptable as the form includes a statutory declaration that must contain original signatures.) If there is time, a ballot will be mailed directly to you. If the addition to the list is after the date by which a voter kit can be safely mailed and returned, electors are asked to bring the form directly to the Forest Office, at which time, a ballot will be issued when the form is submitted.

The elector has the opportunity to complete the information immediately, or take the ballot home with them, as long as it is understood that the return envelope **must be received in the Forest office no later than 8:00 p.m., Monday, October 25, 2010.**
