

## **PUBLIC SKATING RULES**

- All public skates end 10 minutes prior to posted end time to allow for a flood unless staff deem it necessary sooner
- Children must be directly supervised by an adult on the ice
- No food or drink on the ice surface
- No horseplay, tag, racing, rough play, figure skating, etc.
- No throwing snow
- No balls, sticks, chairs, pylons, etc. on the ice surface
- No electronic devices
- Skate helpers/aids are available for use for those who require the assistance
- Strollers may be pushed by an experienced skater and must stay to the outer edge of the ice
- Skate in the direction of all skaters
- Skate guards must be worn in the front lobby; no wheelie guards
- Skates must be worn while on the ice surface
- Helmets are strongly recommended for everyone on the ice
