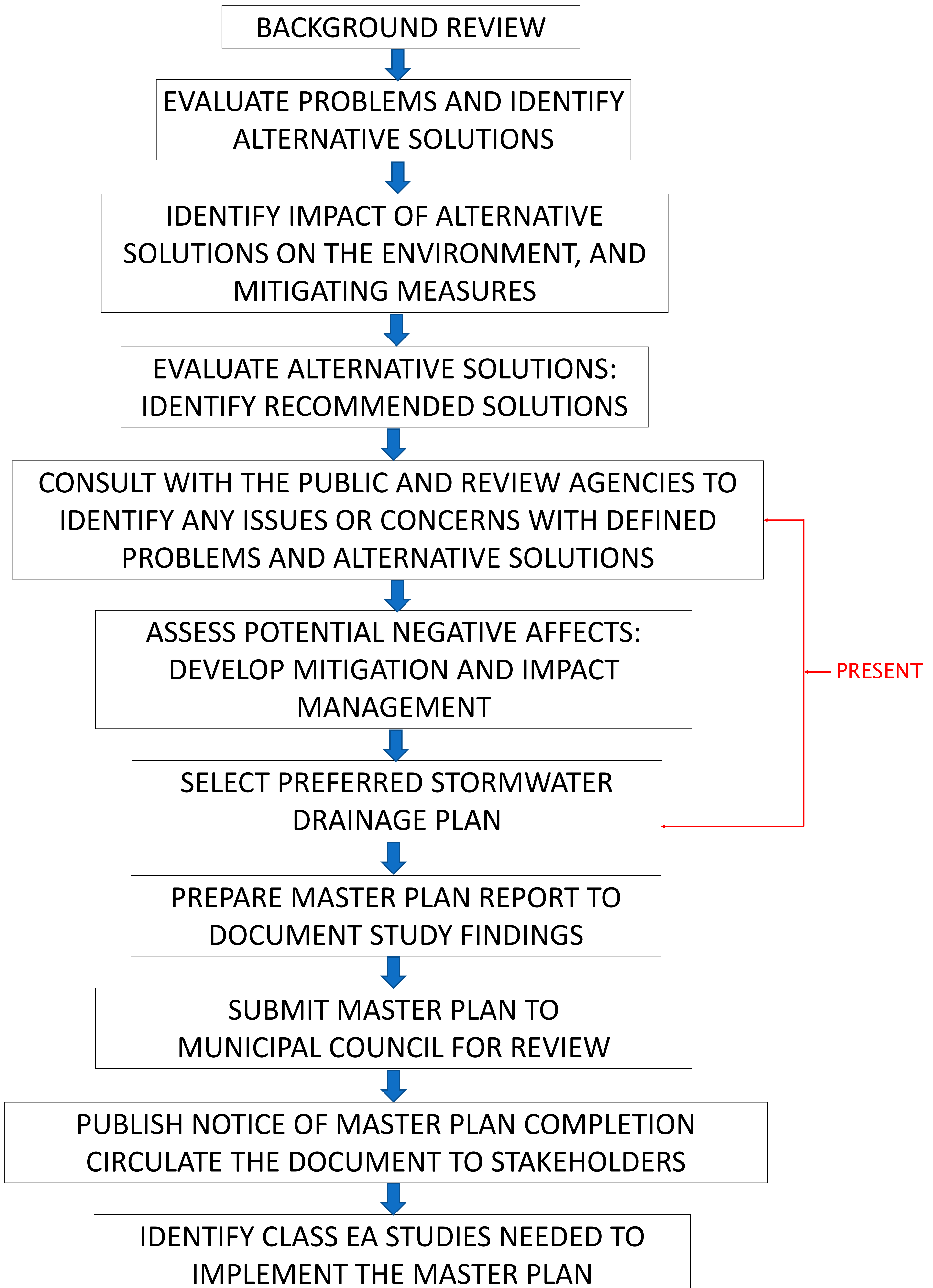
SUMMARY OF MASTER PLAN PROCESS:

- LONG RANGE PLANS DESIGNED TO INTEGRATE INFRASTRUCTURE REQUIREMENTS WITH ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT PLANNING PRINCIPLES
- EXAMINES A GROUP OF RELATED PROJECTS IN ORDER TO OUTLINE A FRAMEWORK FOR PLANNING FOR SUBSEQUENT PROJECTS AND/OR DEVELOPMENTS
- INVOLVES CONSULTATION WITH THE PUBLIC, REGULATORY AGENCIES, INDIGENOUS COMMUNITIES AND AFFECTED PROPERTY OWNERS

SCOPE OF THIS STUDY:

- EXAMINE EXISTING STORMWATER DRAINAGE FEATURES AND FACILITIES IN FOREST AND INVENTORY COMPONENTS
- IDENTIFY GENERAL AREAS OF CONCERN WHICH NEED TO BE ADDRESSED
- DEVELOP RECOMMENDATIONS FOR IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN EXISTING DEVELOPED AREAS OF CONCERN
- CONSULT WITH RESIDENTS, INDIGENOUS COMMUNITIES AND REVIEW AGENCIES
- PROVIDE A PROPOSED PHASING PLAN FOR UPGRADES TO IMPLEMENT OVER A 20 - 25 YEAR TIMEFRAME
- PREPARE A REPORT DOCUMENTING THE MASTER PLAN PROCESS AND STUDY RECOMMENDATIONS
