- \*Please do not interfere with or damage any water safety equipment-this may be needed to save lives
- \*Please use the waste recycling and composting facilities located at the back of the Harbour Building
- \*Please ask the front office for details on facilities for hazardous waste: waste engine oil, lead acid batteries etc.
- \*Guard against all risk of fire and please only light fires in designated areas. Only natural fire wood is to be burned in the park. No scrap lumber or building materials.
- \*Please do not damage or interfere with fencing, tables seating and signs.
- \*Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.
- \*Any boat repairs, washing or painting within the Harbour Area is strictly prohibited
- \*Berthing only in designated areas.
