
THE 2024 PLAN TO RENEW THE HERITAGE SHOPPING DISTRICT OF FOREST

#### OUR GOAL AS A MULTI GROUP COMMITTEE

#### TRAFFIC FLOW

- The one-way concept was the clear choice among three choices that we initially came up with.
- It has been presented to key players in the downtown to overwhelming acceptance.



#### SIDEWALK RECONSTRUCTION

- Changing the traffic flow not only allows for more parking it allows for our sidewalks to be extended up to a meter in total.
- This will allow for greater pedestrian safety and potential patio scenarios



# FOCAL POINTS

- We see focal points within the downtown
- This will aid in attracting visitors who may otherwise dismiss the downtown as they pass through on highway 21
- Focal points will create interest and athletics within the area









#### **PARKING**

- With the new one-way traffic flow parking spaces will be increased by nearly 10%
- Parking will become less stressful with the 45-degree angle parking and our demographic isn't getting any younger

- Art Festivals




## SEASONAL USE - WINTER
